About the Catholic Bible Institute

PROGRAM

The Catholic Bible Institute is a three-year program which involves a comprehensive study of the Hebrew and Christian Scriptures, with particular focus on methods of study, sharing and praying with scripture, and application of skills in bible-study leadership.

Year One includes an introduction to the Hebrew scriptures and an overview of the following themes: Into to the Hebrew Scriptures, Pentateuch & Torah, Historical Writings, Prophets, Exile & Rebuilding, Deutero-canonical Writings, Wisdom Literature & Hebrew Theology.

Year Two includes an introduction to the New Testament and an overview of the following: Mark, Matthew, Luke/Acts, Johannine Writings, Pauline Writings, Disputed Letters, Pastoral Letters, Revelation, Early Christian Writings & New Testament Theology.

Year Three focuses on developing practical skills for working with groups, with an emphasis on adult learning, facilitation skills, group process, working with bible-study resources, and leadership training.



GOAL

- To grow in appreciation of God's revealed Word
- To foster a Catholic understanding of the study of scripture
- To integrate bible-study with prayer and Christian living
- To provide formation and training for parish-based bible study

LEVELS OF STUDY

1. **CERTIFICATE IN BIBLICAL STUDIES**
 - To provide leadership training for bible-study
 - To provide a working knowledge of scripture
 - To provide skills to lead parish-based scripture programs
 - To foster participant's spiritual growth
 - To broaden participant's understanding of scripture.
2. **ENRICHMENT**

Those seeking personal enrichment are encouraged in their studies through participation with those seeking certification (limited to space availability as priority is given to those seeking certification).

The Catholic Bible Institute is an experiential learning opportunity. A team of facilitators utilizes a variety of instruction methods appropriate to adult learning. These methods include:

- Presentation by qualified Biblical instructors

- Communal praying of scripture
- Monthly reading assignments including scripture passages and Biblical commentaries
- Monthly reflection papers
- Additional written assignments required for certification.
